

This unrealistic and unsustainable demand would make health care unaffordable for the patients and members we serve and will not close the agreement.

**Our offer: industry-leading raises and benefits with a strong foundation for the future.**


Kaiser Permanente has proposed a strong **21.5% wage increase totaling about 30%**, including step increases, by the end of the contract. This breaks out to incremental increases of 6.5%, 6.5%, 3%, 2.5%, and 3%, plus step increases.
